



Taking Community Benefit to the Next Level

Strategically using the CHIP to:

- Engage health system staff, leadership, and clinicians
- Integrate with health system strategic plan
- Develop multidisciplinary programs and strategies
- Identify ways to measure impact; focus on outcomes; track progress
- Continue to work with community partners



DC Healthy Communities Collaborative

- In January 2012, 4 hospitals and 4 community health centers entered into a formal partnership to develop a citywide CHNA and implementation strategy
- Ex-officio members include DC Hospital Association & DC Primary Care Association
- Community Advisory Board includes 8 members representing several social determinants of health in DC




4 CHNA Prioritized Needs

- Mental Health: prevention and treatment of psychological, emotional, and relational issues that lead to higher quality of life
- Bringing Care to the Community (Place-Based Care): care options that are convenient and culturally sensitive
- Care Coordination: deliberate organization of patient care activities and information sharing protocols among all of the participants concerned with a patient's care to achieve safer and more effective care
- Health Literacy: ability to obtain, process, and understand basic health information and services needed to make appropriate health decisions




Health Impact Pyramid
